



Stylist Tips for The Adjust-a-Sink®

The Adjust-a-Sink® is easy to use and operate making it the most comfortable shampoo bowl that a stylist can use.

- The side pump which adjusts the height of the bowl is adjusted in a similar manner to a hydraulic chair; however when the client is reclined at the bowl and you are adjusting the bowl, remind the client that the bowl will lift slightly as you adjust it down. Ask the client to lift their head at this initial adjustment.
- The client will sit most comfortably when seated upright at an approximate 45 degree angle. If your chair is accidentally positioned too far back, simply move it slightly forward; this will reduce any unnecessary pressure on the neck. With the standard shampoo bowl the client is familiar with sitting in the middle of the chair; this is not necessary with the Adjust-a-Sink®.
- When serving a client who is seated in a wheelchair, raise the sink so the handles of the wheelchair slide under either side of the underside of the bowl. Adjust the bowl and encourage the client to sit in a position as noted above to ensure the most comfortable fit between their neck and the bowl. Based on the physical condition of the client, you may need to experiment with the height of the bowl and/or the use of a cape or “funnel” to ensure the most comfortable and driest position for the client /facility resident. - When the client is very tall and the stylist short in stature you may want to make an exception and ask the client to sit in the middle of the chair so the stylist can keep the Adjust-a-Sink® in a lower position for better stylist comfort. This position will be somewhat similar to what they are familiar with in the standard bowl; only they will be more comfortable due to the adjustable feature of our product.
- When rinsing hair color or perm solution out of the client’s hair you want to be certain the Adjust-a-Sink® is positioned slightly lower. This will allow the neck to rest comfortably on the shampoo bowl and not on the rods; it will also allow for a more through rinsing of hair color without lifting the clients head.
- Your personal adjustments will allow for greater comfort for you the stylist and for your client. With the Adjust-a-Sink®, you now have adjustment options never before available with the standard, fixed height shampoo bowl.
